We adhere to the Australian Privacy Principles established in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).

1. Type of personal information collected

3. Disclosure of personal information

If we are required to provide personal information to a third party in order to fulfil our business functions and services on your behalf, we will request that the third party follow this Privacy Policy.

By providing us with your personal information you expressly consent to Adminify disclosing, distributing, sharing, passing on, renting, licencing or selling personal information to third parties (including subcontractors) for the following purposes:

You may opt out of allowing us to:

We will endeavour to promptly correct any information found to be inaccurate, incomplete or out of date.

5. Complaints about breach

If you believe that we have breached the Australian Privacy Principles and wish to make a complaint about that breach, please contact us on the email address below outlining your contact details and specifics of the alleged breach. We will endeavour to investigate your complaint within 30 days of receipt, after which we will contact you on the details provided to resolve the issue, and if necessary make the required disclosure to the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner.

We retain the right to amend or to make changes and deletions to this Privacy Policy at any time and at our sole discretion. Your ongoing use of our website and/or our service following any amendment indicates that you accept the amendment.
